Day 1/ Sunday March 11, ARRIVAL IN JAPAN (KIX) – KYOTO (-,-,D)

Arrival at Kansai international airport.(KIX) After immigration and customs procedure make your way to the hotel on your own (Private transfer available at extra cost). The remainder of your day is at leisure. Later tonight, join the group for a welcome dinner. Overnight in Kyoto

Day 2/ Monday March 12 2018, Kyoto (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel restaurant. This morning we will start the tour of Kyoto by coach with our English speaking guide visiting - Nijo Castle- Kinkakuji Temple;. Tour the historical “ World Heritage” castle, completed in 1626, which was built to provide lodging for Tokugawa Shogun and as a palladium for Kyoto Imperial Palace. The impressive, elaborate carvings and decors in the Ninomaru Palace are a must-see. Lunch in a local restaurant. Afternoon visit of Heian Shrine- Kiyomizu Temple. Heian Jingu Shrine Don't miss the characteristic red architecture of this beautiful shrine built to celebrate the 1100 year anniversary of the founding of the city of Kyoto. Kiyomizu-dera Temple. The view of Kyoto from the World Heritage Site Kiyomizu-dera is superb. The historic shopping lane that leads to the temple adds to a wonderful experience. Return to your hotel in Kyoto in the afternoon and dinner near your hotel. Overnight in Kyoto.

Day 3/ Tuesday March 13 2018, Kyoto – Nara – Kyoto (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning departure for Nara by chartered coach with our English-speaking guide visiting- Todaiji Temple- Nara Sacred Deer Park- Kasuga Shrine. World Heritage sites. This is the symbol of the Nara Period and one of the world's largest wooden structures. Its huge main hall and bronze Great Buddha are impressive to behold. Kasuga Taisha Shrine. This Nara Period shrine is designated as a World Heritage Site. The deer of Nara Park are thought to be the shrine messengers. Transfer back to Kyoto for your overnight at your hotel in Kyoto and dinner near your hotel. Overnight in Kyoto.

Day 4/ Wednesday March 14 2018, Kyoto (B,-,-)

Breakfast at hotel. Full day at leisure. Overnight in Kyoto.

Day 5/ Thursday March 15 2018,, Kyoto – Kanazawa (B,-,D)

Breakfast at hotel. Morning transfer to JR Kyoto station. We will leave Kyoto for Kanazawa by JR limited express (2.5H). Arrive at Kanazawa and start a tour of Kanazawa by coach visiting Kenrokuen Garden- Higashi Chaya-gai - Nagamachi Former Samurai Residential District. The beautiful Kenrokuen garden is considered one of the top three Japanese gardens. It offers amazing seasonal views all year round. Higashi Chaya-gai Wooden-latticed exteriors of teahouses line both sides of the stone-paved street here where something from the Edo period still lingers in the air. This area is an Important Traditional Building Preservation District. Nomura Residence, Nagamachi Samurai District. Visit a former residence of a samurai family from the Kaga Domain. Admire the traditional architecture and gaze at the beautiful Japanese garden. Then transfer to your hotel and check-in at your hotel. Dinner at local restaurant. Overnight in Kanazawa .

Day 6/ Friday March 16 2018, Kanazawa - Shirakawago – Takayama (B,L,D)

Breakfast and check out at hotel. After breakfast meet with your guide in the hotel lobby for a departure to Shirakawago by private coach. Today you will visit the village of Shirakawago located midway between Takayama and Kanazawa. The area borderlines the Shogawa River Valley in the remote mountains that stretch from Gifu all the way to the Toyama prefecture. It is famous for its traditional gassho-zukuri farmhouses, some of which are more than 250 years old and were declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1995. Our first stop will be the Wada house in Shirakawago where you can see what the traditional farmhouses look like from the inside. Look around and be fascinated by the culture and history of the village. Lunch at local restaurant. Then visit of Yatai Kaikan (Takayama Festival Floats Exhibition Hall) This popular facility displays some of the colorfully decorated festival floats used in the famous Takayama Festival. Enjoy seeing the many intricately made floats. Check-in and dinner at your hotel. Overnight in Takayama.

Day 7/ Saturday March 17 2018, Takayama – Tokyo (B, L -)

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast meet with your guide at the hotel for a private guided walking tour of Takayama Jinya Market, also known as the Historical Government House. For almost two centuries this building served as a local government office and it is the only surviving government office building from Edo period. Takayama Jinya now serves as a museum where you will find well-preserved conference and interrogation rooms with old tatami floors and some century-old artifacts. The walk there will lead you through Takayama's beautifully preserved old town, and especially in Sannomachi Street you will find breweries and teahouses that have been in business for centuries. Lunch at a local restaurant, then leave Takayama for Tokyo by private coach (5h scenic drive) . Overnight in Tokyo.

Day 8/ Sunday March 18 2018, Tokyo. (B, L, -)

Breakfast at hotel and checkout. Meet with your guide at the hotel for a departure to start a tour of Tokyo by chartered coach with our English speaking guide visiting- Meiji Shrine- Omotesando & Harajuku. Meiji Jingu Shrine is one of the most distinguished shrines in the country. Step inside the grounds and be surrounded by a sprawling forest which makes visitors forget about this shrine's urban location. Omotesando is a posh fashion, shopping and entertainment neighborhood. Its main street, Omotesando dori, is often compared to the Champs-Élysées in Paris. It's a wide boulevard lined with trees. Lunch at local restaurant. In the afternoon guided visit of Edo Tokyo Museum's permanent exhibition, showcasing original objects and replicas, offers visitors a journey through the 400-year history of Edo-Tokyo since Tokugawa Ieyasu entered Edo. Then visit of Asakusa Kannon & Shopping at Nakamise. Visit the oldest temple in Tokyo as well as Nakamise-dori, the street leading to the temple. Return to your hotel and dinner on your own. Overnight in Tokyo.

Day 9/ Monday March 19 2018, Tokyo (B, -, D)

Breakfast at hotel. Leave Tokyo for Mt. Fuji by coach with English speaking guide visiting- Mt. Fuji 5th station- Fuji Visitor's Center- Hakone National Park. Start the ascent up Mt. Fuji via the Fuji Subaru Line. Climb 2,300 meters (7,546 ft) above sea level for breathtaking views from above the clouds. Mt. Fuji's 5th station is typically 10 to 15 degrees Celsius colder than Tokyo. Please bring a coat and other warm clothing on tours from autumn to spring. Free time for lunch at local restaurant on your own. In the afternoon we will go for a mini sightseeing cruise on Lake Ashi. The Crater Lake was born from a powerful volcanic eruption nearly 3,000 years ago and provides postcard views of Mt. Fuji from various angles. Transfer to your hotel and dinner at your hotel. Overnight in Tokyo.

Day 10/ Tuesday March 20 2018, Tokyo (B, -, D)

Breakfast at hotel. Full day at leisure. Farewell Dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Tokyo.

Day 11/ Wednesday March 21 2018, Tokyo back to the US (B, -, -)

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out from your hotel in Tokyo. Transfer to Narita/Haneda Tokyo Airport on your own (private transfer available at extra cost) for your flight back to the US, or to the TAIPEI extension. (Cross the date line while in flight). SAYONARA

DAY 11/ Wednesday March 21 2018, Tokyo to Taipei.

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out from your hotel in Tokyo. Transfer to Narita/Haneda Tokyo Airport on your own (private transfer available at extra cost) for your flight to Taipei. Arrive in Taipei Taoyuan International Airport. Transfer on your own from the airport to your Taipei hotel (private transfer available at extra cost). Overnight in Taipei.

DAY 12/ Thursday March 22 2018, Taipei (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning meet with your guide for a city tour by coach. View of Martyr's Shrine, famous for its guard changing ceremony. Visit of the National Palace Museum (admission fee included). Lunch at local restaurant followed by a visit of Vigor Pineapplecake / Pastry shop. Then guided visit of CKS Memorial Hall, Lungshan Temple, and the observatory. Dinner at a local restaurant. Transfer back to hotel. Overnight in Taipei.

DAY 13/ Friday March 23 2018, Taipei (B, L, D)

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning meet with your tour guide and begin city tour by coach of the Yehliu National Geo Park. Lunch at local restaurant, then transfer to Jiufen. Visit of Jiufen Old Street, then Transfer to Shifen Old Street and Lantern Releasing experience (3-4 guests to share 1 lantern). Transfer back to Taipei city. Dinner at local restaurant Shilin Night market. Transfer back to hotel. Overnight in Taipei.

DAY 14/ Saturday March 24 2018, Taipei (B, L, -)

Breakfast at hotel. Meet with your tour guide and begin city tour by coach. Visit the Taipei Confucius Temple, Shuanglian Morning Market and Dihua Street. Lunch at local restaurant, then Transfer to Tamsui area, Fisherman's Wharf, Tamsui Old Street. Transfer back to hotel. Evening at leisure. Overnight in Taipei.

DAY 15/ Sunday March 25 2018, Taipei (B, -, -)

Breakfast at hotel. Day at leisure. Then transfer to Taoyuan International Airport on your own (Private transfer available at extra cost) for your flight back to the USA. End of the Services.

Seat assignments: We block group seats with many major carriers, as well as chartered air carriers. We have absolutely no control over seat assignment. Specific seat requests are subject to availability at airport check-in only or passengers may contact the airlines for individual specific seating once tickets have been issued. Passenger "Record locators" are assigned by the airlines once the airlines have ticketed each passenger from the group block. This usually occurs between 60 to 30 days prior the departure date. After the airlines have assigned each traveler a "record locator", travelers may contact the airlines directly to discuss his or her seat preference. Airlines may impose additional fees for specific seats.

Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 180 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services.
