ITINERARY - 13 DAYS

The Women's Travel Group believes in combining country highlights with areas that are overlooked by generic tours. This itinerary covers sophisticated Buenos Aires, colonial Salta (founded 1582) and the finest wine vistas in Mendoza. We did not want you to miss the natural beauties of Iguazu Falls or UNESCO Heritage Humahuaca in NW Argentina on the border with Chile. Since we travel as a group, we only include only one option: a half day side trip to Uruguay's lush Tigre River area.

The trip is planned for fine weather. Internal flights are efficient, allowing us to see the maximum. Food is varied with local specialties and wine tastings in Mendoza. Room shares can be arranged first come first served.

Day 1 - THURSDAY, AUGUST 08, 2013 - MIAMI / BUENOS AIRES

Depart from Miami late this evening on board LAN Argentina for Buenos Aires. *Please ask about your connecting flight to Miami.*

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Day 2 - FRIDAY, AUGUST 09, 2013 - BUENOS AIRES

Morning arrival at Buenos Aires International airport (EZE), welcome by local guide and transfer to your hotel. Later, enjoy a guided walking tour to La Recoleta, one of the city's most glamorous spots. Overnight at Loi Suites Recoleta Hotel (Standard room).

Day 3 - SATURDAY, AUGUST 10, 2013 - BUENOS AIRES (BD)

Tour Buenos Aires today. Get in touch with the birth city of the Tango! During this tour you will visit the famous Avenida de Mayo that runs into the Plaza De Mayo, surrounded by the Casa Rosada (Government House), the Metropolitan Cathedral and the Cabildo (first City Hall, built during Spanish rule). At the other end of Avenida de Mayo it's possible to see the impressive Congress building.

We continue to San Telmo, a historical neighborhood and the eldest district of Buenos Aires.

Our next stop is La Boca, a most colorful area with the famous street Caminito. Driving along 9 de Julio Avenue, the widest avenue of the world, you see the Colon Theatre, a famous Opera House that stages the most important artists and musicians from all over the world.

Continue to Palermo with its beautiful parks, the City Zoo, Botanical Garden, Argentine Horse Track and National Polo Fields. Palermo is well-known for its artificial lakes. At the end of the tour you will visit Recoleta area, one of the city's most glamorous spots. Here you will find the Municipal Cultural Center, elegant boutiques and excellent restaurants, surrounded by centennial trees. At the cemetery of Recoleta you will find the grave of Eva Duarte, known in the whole world as Eva Perón (Evita). The cemetery is the centre of this aristocratic neighbourhood, and the more relevant personalities of Argentina's history rest in this place. The mausoleums and pantheons reflect the architectural diversity emerging from the different cultural tendencies Argentina incorporated in its formation as a nation. The cemetery is considered to be one of the most impressive monuments of Argentina.

Evita Museum visit - Created on September 1998, Evita Museum is devoted to disclosing the life, work and set of beliefs and values of María Eva Duarte de Perón. The traveling exhibitions invite visitors to take a tour through Evita's thoughts and actions.

This evening, transfer from the hotel and drive to the Tango Porteño for dinner including drinks. Then enjoy the tango show with its music, singing and dancing.

Day 4 - SUNDAY, AUGUST 11, 2013 - BUENOS AIRES (B)

The day is at leisure at your disposal to be spent with one of the many highlights Buenos Aires has to offer as optionals.

Day 5 - MONDAY, AUGUST 12, 2013 - BUENOS AIRES / IGUAZU FALLS (B)

This morning transfer to the Airport (AEP) to board your flight to Iguazu.

Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the hotel.

Argentine Falls Visit - depart from the hotel for Iguazu Falls. Arrive at the Visitors Center and the Iguazu National Park Entrance. Board a gas-propelled train at the Main Station, which will take you to the upper falls circuit and the Devil's Throat (Garganta del Diablo), the most prominent and one of the highest falls. Be surprised by a strategic lookout point resting on the side of the gorgeous Devil's Throat. Visitors can then walk more than 3 km along the Iguazú river canyon, via the lower circuit and the upper circuit to appreciate the flora and fauna. Overnight at Loi Suites Iguazu hotel 5* (Studio Jr. Room).

Day 6 TUESDAY, AUGUST 13, 2013 - IGUAZU FALLS / SALTA (BD)

Transfer this morning to Iguazu Airport (IGR) to board your flight to Salta

Arrival at Salta, where you will be met and transferred to the hotel. Overnight at Ayres de Salta hotel 4* (Standard room)

Day 7 - WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 14, 2013 - SALTA (BD)

Take a city tour of Salta today. We will do an outside visit of the Cathedral, the 9 de Julio Square, the Archbishop's Palace and the Cabildo as well as other main buildings, as they are only open late afternoon. We will also go by bus to the San Bernardo Hill. During the tour we will pass through the residential areas, built in colonial style. After this visit we will continue to San Lorenzo, a small village about 10 km away from Salta. Last stop of the city tour is the Art and Crafts Market of Salta.

This evening, enjoy dinner and a folklore show to a traditional Peña. Overnight at Ayres de Salta hotel 4* (Standard room)

Day 8 - THURSDAY, AUGUST 15, 2013 - SALINAS GRANDES & PURMAMARCA (BL)

This morning depart for the Quebrada de Humahuaca area. Indigenous traditions are kept alive in this fascinating area, full of local traditions, cuisine and music surrounded by the multicolored hillsides. Quebrada de Humahuacas frames several villages: Purmamarca, Maimara, Tilcara and Humahuaca. Colorful hills feature adobe homes, historical chapels, and pre Hispanic Ruins. This place was declared a Cultural World Heritage site by UNESCO.

We will visit the town of Purmamarca, which offers view to the Cerro de los siete Colores (Mountain of Seven Colors) with its amazing colors going from brown to violet and from red to green. Continuing along via the impressive Cuesta de Lipan we will continue our trip to Salinas Grandes, one of the most important attractions in this circuit. The scenery looks like an endless white horizon that the sun

illuminates with different colors. Salinas Grandes is located in la Puna area, once part of the Inca Road.

We will return back to Purmamarca via Cuesta de Lipan and in the afternoon return back to Salta city.

Day 9 - FRIDAY, AUGUST 16, 2013 - SALTA / MENDOZA (B)

Transfer this morning to Salta airport to board your flight to Mendoza.

Arrival at Mendoza airport and transfer to the hotel. Overnight at Diplomatic hotel 5* (Standard room).

Day 10 - SATURDAY, AUGUST 17, 2013 - MENDOZA (BL)

Enjoy the pleasure of visiting one of the best enological areas in Argentina. In the morning you will meet the guide who will accompany us throughout the tour. Then you will depart to Mendoza's agricultural oasis, and visit three wineries of the wine circuit. There you will enjoy a wine tasting session, during which you will begin to familiarize with the local's wines, and its elaboration process.

The local guide will explain the techniques of wine tasting and wine production, the importance of the cork in the bottle and the correct way to handle a glass in order to taste the wine. In the afternoon return back to Mendoza city.

Day 11 - SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 2013 - MENDOZA (BL)

Travel west up to the Chilean border, a route that travels along the Potrerillos dam and Mendoza river. Enjoy beautiful landscapes of foothills before arriving at Uspallata village. Pass by Picheuta Bridge, Polvaredas, Punta de Vacas and the ski center Los Penitentes. Stop at Puente del Inca, a natural formation which mixes yellow and red colors in its ruins and hot springs and rises up to approximately 2700 meters high.

Arrive in Las Cuevas, a small village which borders Chile. With excellent weather conditions during the summer, there is the possibility of reaching the Cristo Redentor monument. Alternately a small trek at Los Horcones Lagoon can be arranged, with allows for a great view of the Aconcagua's Mount.

Day 12 - MONDAY, AUGUST 19, 2013 - MENDOZA / BUENOS AIRES / MIAMI (BD)

This afternoon, transfer to Mendoza airport to board your flight back to Buenos Aires.
