July 25 Dinner with brandy or tequila

After landing, please proceed to the baggage claim area. Take luggage and leave the security area, our transfer staff will wait for you at 3PM - please look for a sign with your name and or The Women's Travel Group. Private transfers available optionally at \$80 per car, 1- 3 people .

Transfer to our hotel near the main plaza, cathedral and fine shopping. Meet for dinner in the lobby 7pm. Our guide will walk us to and from a charming restaurant where we enjoy fine Mexican cuisine. The Café de Tacuba was inaugurated in 1912 near Plaza de la Constitución and is now part of the traditional gastronomy of Mexico City. Enjoy typical Mexican home cuisine in a cosy atmosphere. Whether stuffed chili, Pambachitos, Panuchos or a Torta de Enchilada, the restaurant will delight. For dessert how about hot chocolate "estilo Tacuba".

Day 2 Mexico City Hampton Inn & Suites by Hilton ** (****)**

July 26 Buffet Breakfast and Dinner with glass of wine



One of the largest cities in the world is going to leave you amazed. Mexico City is the political, social and cultural center of the country with many universities, museums, and monuments. We walk and visit the presidential palace and Diego Rivera murals, Zócalo and cathedral.

Continue to Coyoacán a southern suburb, meaning "place of coyotes".

Besides a short walk through the historic and picturesque center of Coyoacán, we visit the Museo Frida Kahlo at Casa Azul (the "blue house"). Nearby, the Russian exile León Trotsky lived in a simple house, which can be visited optionally.

Continue to Xochimilco, in the south of Mexico City, known for its floating gardens the Aztecs created to supply its capital. The channels of the "Huertos Flotantes" continue more than 90 miles. The gardens were declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987 and are popular with locals and tourists. On a small boat tour you get to know the gardens.

Dinner tonight in the historic San Angel Inn located in a former hacienda that dates back to 1692. The colonial ambience underlies this modern restaurant that has met the highest standards for more than 50 years. Just a few steps from the Diego Rivera y Frida Kahlo museum, you are served exquisite fusion Mexican international cuisine.

Day 3 Mexico City Hampton Inn & Suites by Hilton ** (****)**

The Museo Nacional de Antropología is the most famous museum of its in the world. It has 12 exhibition halls, each dedicated to a different pre-Columbian civilization of Mexico and which total nearly 20-acres. Designed 1964 by a team led by architect Pedro Ramírez Vázquez, the monumental construction is truly fabulous. Discover the civilizations of the Olmec, Toltec, Aztecs and Maya, among many others.

Mexico City - Teotihuacán (49.0 km / 70 Min.)



Visit of the huge pyramid complex of Teotihuacán: the first city in the “New World.” Built between 250 BC and 700 AD, its population, amounted to 125,000 – 250,000 people in 2,300 apartment complexes; , it certainly was the largest metropolis on the American continent. Only when you walk along the mighty “Avenue of the Dead” (about 1 km long) will you become aware of the dimensions of the site. The excavations, ongoing for many years, expand knowledge of this civilization every day.

Teotihuacán - Mexico dCity (50.0 km / 73 Min.)

Dinner at the Limosneros This gourmet restaurant, beautifully appointed in modern Mexican style, has fast gained a reputation of being one of the best in town. The innovative menu – chicken with walnut and Puebla chili sauce to spareribs with agave syrup is modern cuisine. Do not forget to leave room for a fabulous selection of ice cream.
